HDRC show

To be held at Rosethorpe Equestrian Centre, Seaton Ross, Melbourne, YO42 4RF

Monday 27th May 2019

- *(Stallions allowed but must be handled by persons over 18 years of age)*
- Points sash on the day for HDRC members only. Highest placed senior and junior members in each class will get points. The senior and junior members at the end of the day with the most points will be awarded the members points show sash. Points will be awarded for 1st to 6th place: 12 points 1st, 10 points 2nd, 8 points 3rd, 6 points 4th, 4 points 5th, 2 points 6th.
- CLASS ENTRY FEE: £5.00 HDRC MEMBERS / £8.00 NON MEMBERS.

This show is affiliated to Equine Sports UK (ESUK) Grassroots Championships taking place at Arena UK, Grantham, Lincolnshire on 1st-4th August 2019. The three highest placed exhibits will qualify in each class.

This show is affiliated to Equifest, taking place at the East of England Showground on the 29th August-1st September 2019. The two highest placed exhibits not already qualified in each class will qualify.

RING 1: In hand classes – 9:00 am start

The three highest placed exhibits in classes 1-9 will qualify for ESUK championship show

The two highest placed exhibits in classes 2 will qualify for Equifest

1. **Best condition** – open to horses and ponies
2. **Spillers/Equifest Mountain & Moorland in hand.** Open to In Hand Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Connemara, dales, Dartmoor, Exmmor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A,B,C,D. Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. This class may be divided as appropriate.
3. **Youngstock** – horses and ponies 1-3 years of age
4. **Part bred** – open to horses and ponies of all condition
5. **Coloured** – open to horses and ponies of all condition
6. **Veteran in hand** – open to horses and ponies 15 years and over
7. **Ex race horse** – open to horses of all condition

Followed by the in hand championship. 1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 1-7. Championship and reserve split for children (16 years and under) and adults (17 years and over). Sash and £20 to champion. Sash and £10 to reserve.

LUNCH BREAK

RING 1: Ridden classes to follow on. Not before 12:30pm. Lead reins allowed unless stated otherwise.

The three highest place exhibits in classes 8, 9, 11, 12, 13, 14 & 15 will qualify for ESUK championship show

The two highest placed exhibits in classes 11 will qualify for Equifest

8. **Child lead rein** – riders up to 8 years, snaffle bridle, no spurs
9. **First ridden** – riders 9 years and under, no lead reins, ponies not to exceed 13.2hh

10. **Novice ridden** – open to any horse or pony combination who have not won a ridden class. No spurs, no lead reins, snaffle bridle only. Walk and trot only on the go round. Canter not compulsory in the individual show.
11. **Equifest Open Ridden Mountain & Moorland**. Open to In Hand Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Connemara, dales, Dartmoor, Exmmor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A,B,C,D. Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Rider any age. This class may be divided as appropriate.
12. **Coloured** - open to horses and ponies. This class may be divided as appropriate
13. **Part bred**s - open to horses and ponies
14. **Veteran ridden** - open to horses and ponies 15 years and over
15. **Ex race horse** – open to horse of all condition

Followed by the ridden championship. 1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 8-15. Championship and reserve split for children (16 years and under) and adults (17 years and over). Sash and £20 to champion. Sash and £10 to reserve.

RING 2: Fun classes 10:00 am start

Fun ring – ridden or in hand. Ridden will only be allowed to walk and trot. No cantering in the fun ring. Rosettes to all entries

5. Best mare
